LEMO RoHS Compliant Certificate

On 2nd January 2013, Directive 2002/95/EC is repealed by Directive 2011/65/EU known as the recast of the RoHS Directive or as the RoHS 2 Directive.

In 2015, Directive 2015/863, known as RoHS 3, was published by the EU expanding the scope of the actual Directive by adding 4 additional restricted substances (phthalates) to the existent list of 6.

This last Directive bans as of 22nd July 2019 the introduction of products that contain excess of allowable concentrations of now 10 identified hazardous chemicals:

- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate 0.1% (DEHP)
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) 0.1%
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) 0.1%

Listed in Annex III of Directive 2011/65/EU, the exemption 6(c) granted for lead is applicable to the LEMO products, authorizing copper alloys containing up to 4% lead by weight.

LEMO certifies that connectors and accessories produced and supplied under the brands LEMO, REDEL and COELVER are compliant with 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU of the European Parliament.
